Horse welfare survey: What 'works well' in your equine activities?

This 20-minute survey seeks to understand what practices decision-makers believe are working well for welfare in the industry. It is open to adults who:

- Have an interest in the welfare of horses, donkeys or mules
- Contribute to horse welfare decision-making, as an individual, or as a committee or team member
- Are currently involved with the horse racing, riding, sport or tourism sectors, with three or more years of experience.

Decision-makers include stewards, judges, officials, managers, committee members, paid administrators, veterinarians, senior riders/drivers contributing to event organisation, and horse welfare officers who may or may not be active riders, drivers or handlers.
